3. What is my fee and how is the fee calculated?

The stormwater utility fee is \$6.40 per month for single-family residential property with up to 4,400 square feet of impervious or hard surface area – rooftops and pavement. The fee is \$12.80 per month for single-family residential property with more than 4,400 square feet of impervious surface area. The fee for other property is calculated at a rate of \$6.40 per 2,200 square feet of impervious surface area. For example, a building and parking lot with 22,000 square feet of impervious surface area would be billed \$64 per month (10 x \$6.40). You can estimate your bill by viewing the City’s Geographic Information System (GIS) maps and photos of your parcel, and estimating the amount of rooftop, parking lot, driveway and other hard surface area by clicking the link below. Owners of property other than single-family residential also can estimate their bill by clicking the link below.
