

13.12.090 - Fees and rates.

- A. For inspection and approval of water taps and meter installations by developers, tap fees for meters of four inches or less shall apply as established by the mayor and council from time to time by resolution. Tap fees for meters larger than four inches shall be calculated by the city engineer, based on residential use of three hundred fifty (350) gpd or such actual historic demand data as may be available at the time of such calculation. An oversized tap or meter may not be installed for the purpose of obtaining a more favorable tap fee.
- B. The foregoing tap fees shall be applicable to all water taps installed in the city water system, wherever such taps are located.
- C. The following rates shall apply to all customers other than those industrial customers subject to subsection D of this Section, wherever the water is delivered:

Monthly Billings

First 3,000 gallons or less, minimum	\$18.05
3,001 to 50,000 gallons, per 1,000 gallons	6.00
All over 50,000 gallons, per 1,000 gallons	6.15

- D. The following rates shall apply to all industrial customers utilizing an average in excess of fifty thousand (50,000) gallons per day in a billing cycle, wherever the water is delivered:

Monthly Billings

First 3,000 gallons or less, minimum	\$17.65
All over 3,001 gallons, per 1,000 gallons	5.80

Industrial customer shall have the meaning ascribed at Section 13.08.290(B) of this title.

13.16.030 - Rates and charges.

The charge for sanitary sewer service shall be six dollars (\$6.00) per thousand gallons of metered water, except that metered water in the following uses shall not be included in the calculation of sanitary sewer service charges:

- A. Separately metered taps installed and used solely for irrigation systems;
- B. Separately metered water used solely for cooling tower service; and
- C. Separately metered water used in processing systems wherein such water never enters the city sanitary sewer system by floor drains or any other means.
- D. Separately metered water used in an industrial user's processing systems in excess of an average fifty thousand (50,000) gpd, where such industrial user discharges industrial waste into the city sanitary sewer or sewerage system and elects to separately meter sewer by a city sewer meter, or other city approved metering device. The charge for separately metered sewer under this item D. shall be six dollars (\$6.00) per thousand gallons of metered sewer.

Prior written approval by the city water and sewer manager of metering devices utilized in the foregoing uses shall be required in order for sewer service customers to qualify for applicable sewer service charge calculations. Costs of installation, calibration and maintenance of metering devices for uses listed in items B., C. and D., above, shall be borne by the customer. Metering devices for uses listed in items B. and C. above shall be calibrated annually. Metering devices for uses listed in item D. above shall be calibrated quarterly.
