WATER & SANITATION SERVICES

Water meters are read at the end of the month. Bills are due the 20th of every month.

Monthly Water Services (Base Rate)

\$17

Your first 1,000 gallons are at a flat rate of \$17.00. Once you exceed the 1,000 gallons, water prices are an additional \$4.00, per every 1,000 gallons.

Monthly Sanitation Services

\$12

Sanitation pick up is scheduled for every Tuesday and Friday. Each household has a four-bag maximum per pick-up. Please have your covered container to the street before 9:00 A.M. Loose garbage, appliances, yard trimmings, or large objects will not be collected.

For the amount due, please refer to your monthly water bill.
